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

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

The diagnostics and preventive dental services are aimed at maintaining oral health, preventing dental problems, and diagnosing issues early to provide timely treatment. These requirements may vary depending on the member's insurance.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Periapical radiograph exposed within the last 12 months.

Crowns


GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Periapical radiograph exposed within the last 12 months.
- 2) Narrative if the radiograph does not clearly indicate the necessity of a crown. Narratives are particularly helpful in those cases of cracked tooth syndrome and other unusual clinical situations.
- 3) Photos may be helpful, but they do not replace the required radiograph.
- 4) Replacement – date of original placement. "

Core Build Up

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Diagnostic Quality Periapical Radiograph within the last 12 months.
- 2) Photo - if necessary; does not replace the required radiograph.
- 3) Narrative - if necessary, in addition to the required radiograph.



ENDODONTHICS

DENTAL CODE SET

D3000 - D3999

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

For retreatments (D3346, D3347, D3348):

X Ray and report with medical necessity are required.

The following procedures cannot be billed as a separate charge to a participant when performed in conjunction with root canal therapy on the same tooth.

- 1) D0220 / D0230 - Intra-operative images
- 2) D0460 - Pulp Vitality Test
- 3) D2940 - Sedative Filling
- 4) D3220 - Pulpotomy
- 5) D3221 - Pulpal Debridement
- 6) D3910 - Surgical Procedure for isolation of tooth with rubber dam
- 7) D3950 - Canal Preparation
- 8) D9110 - Palliative Treatment

Osseous Surgery / Bone Grafting

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Radiographs demonstrating bone loss
- 2) 6-point periodontal probing
- 3) Narrative – if necessary

Soft Tissue Grafting

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Radiographs demonstrating bone loss
- 2) 6-point periodontal probing
- 3) Narrative – if necessary

Soft Tissue Grafting

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) 6-point periodontal probing
- 2) Photos
- 3) Narrative – if necessary "

Scaling and Root Planning

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

If fewer than 4 teeth per quadrant have periodontal probing of greater than 4mm and radiographic bone loss, the benefits will be based on the allowance for D4342.

- 1) Radiographs demonstrating bone loss.
- 2) 6-point periodontal probing. "

PROSTHODONTICS (Removable)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Periapical, bitewings, or panoramic radiograph
- 2) Authorization request

PROSTHODONTICS (Fixed)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Periapical radiograph exposed within the last 12 months.
- 2) Narrative if the radiograph does not clearly indicate the necessity of a crown.
- 3) Photos may be helpful, but they do not replace the required radiograph.



IMPLANTS

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) They must be 18 years old and not pregnant.
- 2) CT scan (D0367/D0383) would be allowed to assist the provider in the evaluation of the implant site and placement.
- 3) Before requesting implants, periodontal health, and dental health (endodontic, extractions, crowns, and fillings) must be completed. Pre-screening and determining eligibility for the implants using periodontal charting, x-rays and a narrative stating why this procedure is necessary.
- 4) Second molar implants will be determined by the review of the clinical narrative and supporting documentation for the request.
- 5) All extraction sites for implants must be healed and radiopaque.
- 6) The provider is responsible for documenting in the dental record the process of verifying pre-existing conditions with the primary care physician (PCP) for implant placement. "

ORAL AND MAXILOFACIAL SURGERY

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Pre-operative radiograph is required.
- 2) Narrative should be included if radiograph does not support the use of the code. "

ADJUNCTIVE GENERAL SERVICE

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1.) Narrative of medical necessity.

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
